

Devon Picnic Maps, Schedule, and Notes

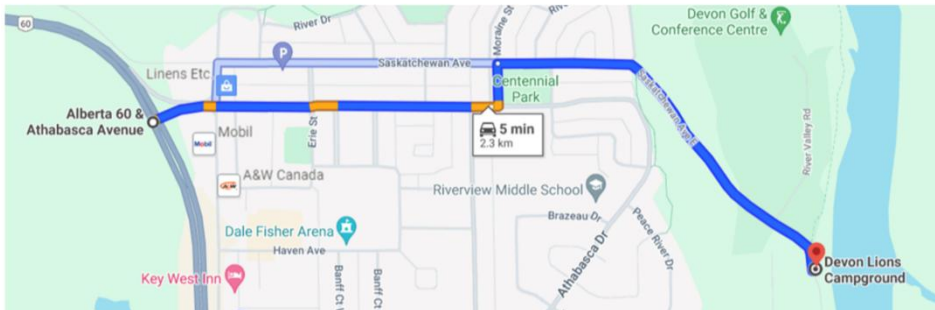
Events:

- 10:00 a.m. Rev. Deborah's service, including communion
Children are inside the gazebo (with Sunday school leaders) decorating their kites during the service and then join the congregation for communion
- 11:00 a.m. Children fly kites and play games
Adults play horseshoes (we're hoping to have a couple of Devon people organize this :)
- 12:00 p.m. Hotdogs and potluck lunch served, including birthday cake for Rev. Deborah (or earlier)
Of course, children are welcome to continue to play after they've eaten!

- Please bring a lawn chair to sit comfortably during the service.
- Devon provides the hotdogs, buns, condiments, bottled water, juice, pop, coffee, tea, cutlery, serviettes.
- Potluck items are welcome if people wish: salad or dessert/fruit or finger foods.

There are picnic tables inside the gazebo for us to eat our lunch together. Of course, some people prefer to sit on their lawn chairs in the sunshine. We've been fortunate that only one year I can recall a bit of rain at our Sunday in the Park!

This is a map showing where you drive to Devon on Hwy 60, turn left (east) onto Athabasca Avenue (the



first entrance into Devon) and drive for 1km, then turn left (north) onto Sylvan Street, and take the first right (east) onto Saskatchewan Avenue for 1.2km, and you will arrive at Devon Lions Campground.

This map is how to find the Devon Lions Campground Gazebo, which is where we bbq the hotdogs and



set up lunch for after the service. I hope you can see my red line drawn along the road leading to the Gazebo (blue octagon shape)!
